From Financial Gaps to Full Confidence

The Challenge



When Corisa joined Burn Prevention Network, she stepped into an organization doing powerful work—but struggling behind the scenes with financial systems that couldn't keep up.

The chart of accounts was confusing and duplicative. Financial statements lacked consistency and accuracy. And the organization didn't have the systems in place to track restricted vs. unrestricted funds—creating risk around funder compliance and long-term sustainability.

"We needed to be able to track by program and by line item," Corisa shared. "But the structure just wasn't there, and that was creating real problems."


Vendor payments were handled manually, documentation was scattered, and reports offered no analysis—leaving board members unsure how to interpret the numbers.



"There were no summaries, no insights," she said. "We were handing over financials without giving our board the tools to understand them."

And while the organization wasn't in a place to hire full-time finance staff, it was clear they needed high-level expertise and reliable support to move forward.

Funder-focused grant tracking.



Scalable financial expertise.


